

## Robin's Class Autumn Term 1 2021

Here is our topic for this half term, please use it to support your child's learning.

### As Linguists we will:

- ❖ Have daily phonics and spelling lessons revising and learning our phonemes and spelling rules (Read, Write, Inc).
- ❖ Read individual letters by saying the sounds for them (year ones to learn digraphs).
- ❖ - Blend sounds into words, so that they can read short words made up of known letter- sound correspondences.
- ❖ - Form lower-case and capital letters correctly.
- ❖ - Spell words by identifying the sounds and then writing the sound with letter/s (year one with set 2 sounds).

### As Athletes we will:

- ❖ Take part in two outdoor sessions of Physical Education per week.
- ❖ Continue to explore fundamentals.
- ❖ Learn how to use large and small equipment safely.

## The Big Question: Is everyone's home the same?



### As Geographers and investigators:

Talk about members of their immediate family and community.

- Name and describe people who are familiar to them.
- Comment on images of familiar situations in the past
- Recognise that people have different beliefs and celebrate special times in different ways
- Understand the effect of changing seasons on the natural world around them.

### As Artists and Design Technologists we will:

Explore, use and refine a variety of artistic effects to express their ideas and feelings.

- Create collaboratively, sharing ideas, resources and skills.
- Listen attentively, move to and talk about music, expressing their feelings and responses.
- Develop storylines in their pretend play.

### As Mathematicians we will:

- ❖ - Link the number symbol (numeral) with its cardinal number value.
- ❖ - Explore the composition of numbers to 10 (year one- find bonds to 10).
- ❖ - Select, rotate and manipulate shapes in order to develop spatial reasoning skills
- ❖ - Continue, copy and create repeating patterns.
- ❖ Compare length, weight and capacity.
- ❖ Count objects, actions and sounds.
- ❖ Year ones- represent and partition numbers to 20 and beyond.

### As Citizens we will:

See themselves as a valuable individual.

- Build constructive and respectful relationships.
- Express their feelings and consider the feelings of others.
- Manage their own needs.
- Further develop the skills they need to manage the school day successfully e.g. lining up and queuing, mealtimes. personal hygiene.
