As mathematicians we will:

- Understand place value in various forms
- Consolidate our addition and subtraction skills
- Consolidate our multiplication and division skills
- Apply our knowledge to problem solving
- Develop our knowledge of the multiplication tables
- Discuss our learning with others using mathematical vocabulary

As Athletes we will:

- ❖ Developing our skills with gymnastics
- ❖ Take part in a competitive game such as dodgeball
- ❖ Develop a range of throwing, catching, running and jumping

As Scientists we will:

- ❖ recognise that living things have changed over time and that fossils provide information about living things that inhabited the Earth millions of years ago

- ❖ identify how animals and plants are adapted to suit their environment in different ways and that adaptation may lead to evolution.

As Geographers we will:

- ❖ Write a descriptive paragraph on a setting

As readers we will:

- ❖ Aim to read at home 4 times per week
